To obtain approval, cadets are required to submit vessel specifications to the Academy Sea Term Coordinator to determine if the vessels meet program requirements for sea time.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

## Cadet are eligible if:

- Conduct: Cadets must be in good standing with the University and the Corps of Cadets to be eligible for MART/MARE 484.
- Academic: Must have completed all prerequisite courses for MART/MARE 200 and successfully completed MART/MARE 200 to enroll in MART/MARE 484.
- License: Cadets must maintain a valid\* MMC, medical certificate, USCG physical, and passport to be eligible for enrollment in MART/MARE 484. \* Valid means the document does not expire within a year of the end of the internship.
