Cindy Morrow '77 received a bachelor's degree in marine sciences from Texas A&M University at Galveston. She was part of the first undergraduate civilian class and one of the first women to attend.

Cindy spent over 30 years working for the Central Intelligence Agency. She became a CIA officer and spent almost half of her career overseas.
